



2010 Non-Resident Black Bear Draw

Important Facts:

- A non-resident Black Bear hunter may acquire a licence by either of the following two methods:
 1. **Through a designated, licensed outfitter or guide who has received an allocation of black bear licences, or**
 2. **By entering and being successful in the computerized random access draw.**
- Non-resident Black Bear Licences are valid for hunting in only one Wildlife Management Zone (see reverse for map).
- Black Bear Licence application fees and/or licence fees are not transferable or refundable.
- All non-resident hunters are required to hunt with a licensed guide.
- Applicants must be 16 years of age or older at the time of application and must not have had their hunting privileges revoked under the authority of the *Fish and Wildlife Act* in New Brunswick.
- A Black Bear Licence is valid for hunting bear during all of the open seasons (Bag limit is one bear per year).
- You may enter the draw singly or as a group (party) of hunters - however, each applicant may enter only one application into the draw, regardless of whether they are applying as a part of a group or as an individual application. If you apply as a group and are successful, all members of the group may purchase a licence.

DRAW APPLICATIONS ARE ACCEPTED FROM **JANUARY 4TH TO FEBRUARY 28TH, 2010.**

NOTE: A \$28.25 (\$25 CDN plus applicable tax) non-refundable application fee for each applicant will be charged to your credit card. For example, if you apply as a party of 4 hunters, you will be charged a total application fee of \$113.00 (4 applications at \$28.25 each).

You will be allocated a draw number. NOTE: **If you are successful in the draw, you must know your draw number in order to purchase your Non-Resident Black Bear Licence(s).** Write this number in the box below and keep this sheet for future reference.

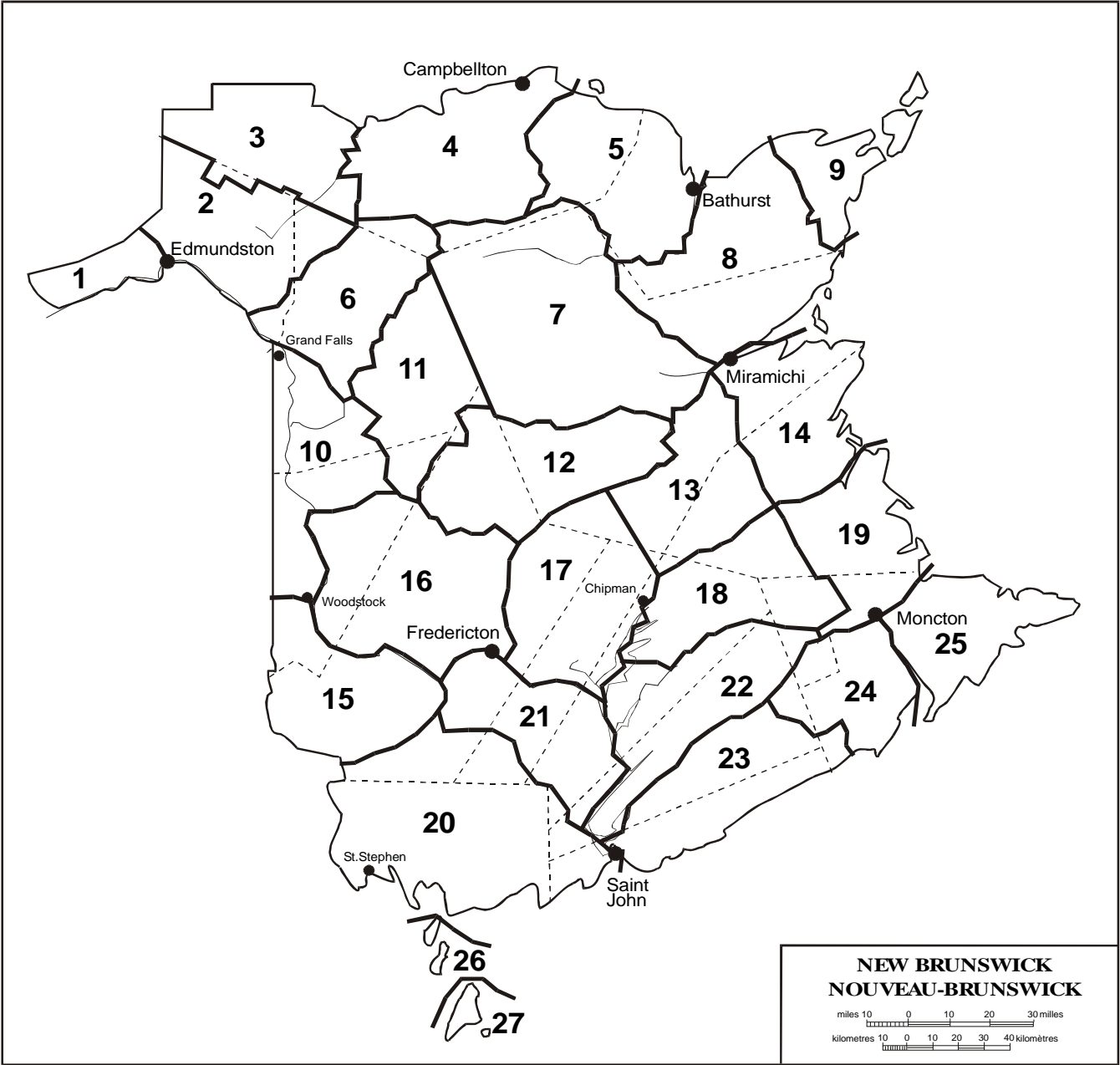
If you are successful in the draw, you may purchase your licence(s) by calling the above telephone number prior to **March 26th, 2010** (\$184.19 CDN per licence, tax included). If you have entered a party application, you must have all your party members' full names, addresses, dates of birth and telephone numbers at the time of licence purchase. Once your payment has been received, you will receive a licence validation sticker in the mail. **This sticker, as well as all other required information, must be presented to obtain your Non-Resident Black Bear Licence at a Department of Natural Resources Office or Service New Brunswick Centre during government business hours (8:15 AM - 4:30 PM, Monday to Friday).**

The Department of Natural Resources has very specific Hunter Education Requirements. All hunters are required to meet these requirements prior to the issuance of a hunting licence. Please refer to the Hunt and Trap booklet that accompany your validation sticker. Note: there are also specific requirements for 16 and 17 year old bear hunters.

Unallocated Licences

All licences not purchased by March 26th, 2010 will be made available on a first-come, first-serve basis, throughout the 2010 season, to other non-resident hunters. Beginning Monday, April 12th, 2010 interested applicants may call the Fish and Wildlife Branch at 506-453-2440 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Atlantic Standard Time to obtain a licence. All licences must be purchased at the time of call and may not be reserved in advance. **Each hunter's name, complete mailing address, date of birth and telephone number must be provided at the time of licence purchase.** A licence validation sticker(s) will be mailed to the licence purchaser. Please allow at least 3 business days if requesting that licences be sent to a Department of Natural Resources district office or Service New Brunswick centre for pick-up.
